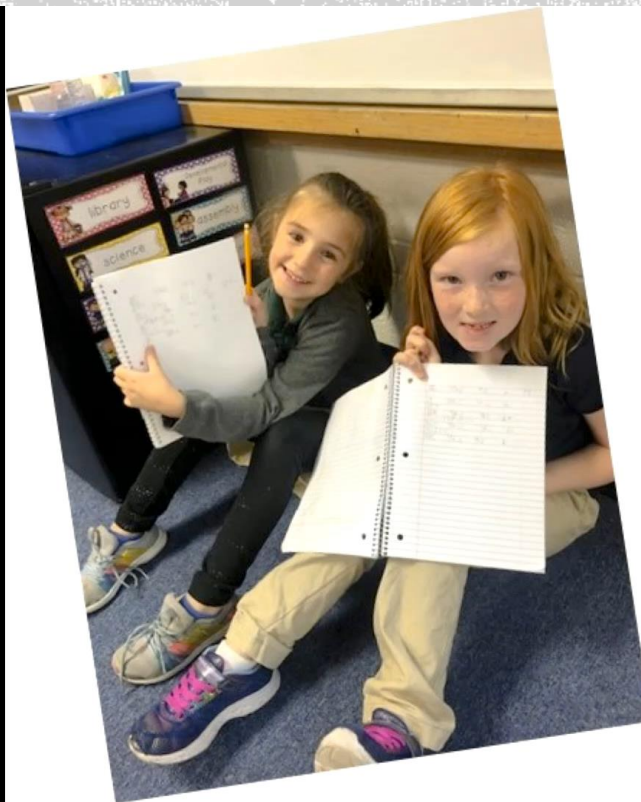

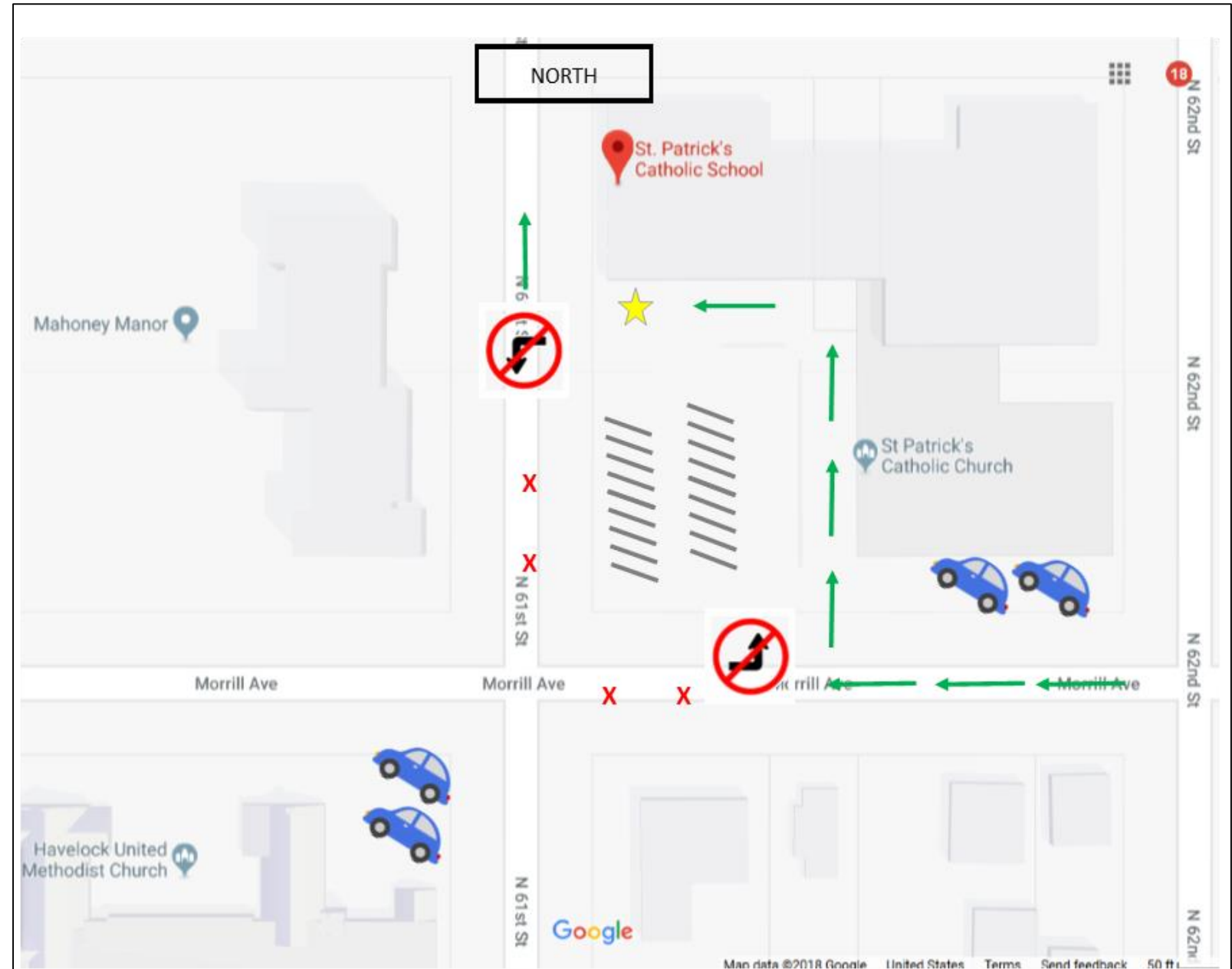


School Day

- School Day: 7:45 – 3:20
 - Students may wait outside from 7:40-7:45
 - Mass 8:00 a.m.
 - Morning Recess begins at 10:30
 - Lunch begins at 11:00
 - Afternoon Recess (PreK-2)
 - Dismissal 3:20

Extended Care

- All students are automatically enrolled
- Hours
 - 7:00 a.m. – 7:40 a.m. & 3:30 - 6:00 p.m.
- Rate
 - \$3.60 per hour for the first child
 - Charged by 15 min. increments
- Students who arrive before 7:40 will be asked to go to extended care
- Students will dismiss with class – if they are not picked up by 3:30 they will go to extended care
- Payment through FACTS



Illness or Absence

- Please call or email the school as soon as you know your child will be absent
- Students with a fever in school or who vomit in school will be sent home
 - Please keep students at home until they are fever or vomit free for 24 hours
 - Please keep students at home until they have had one full meal without vomiting
- Missed work can be picked up via the gym doors on school days until 6 p.m. or after mass on the weekends (use family code to enter gym doors)
- All students coming or leaving during the day must check in with the school office



Dress Code

- Tan or Navy pants/shorts – NO exterior pockets
 - Girls may wear tan or navy skirts with shorts under
 - Girls may wear tan or navy skorts or jumpers
- Green, Navy, or White polo shirts
 - Logos optional
- St. Patrick logo sweatshirt OR any plain sweatshirt in uniform colors
- Hooded sweatshirts as coats only
- Socks with small logos in neutral colors (white, black, gray)
- Hair for boys not to cover ears, eyes, or collar



Lunch

- Families may check balance and pay via cash or check or through MySchoolBucks
- Many families qualify for free & reduced lunch – if you think you might qualify...apply!
 - Money from Federal Grants based on # of families who qualify
- No child will be denied a lunch – please make payments in a timely manner

Teacher Communication

- Teachers are contracted to be at the school from 7:30-3:30
- Teachers will email weekly about what to expect the upcoming week (topics taught in class, reminders, projects, etc.)
- Each teacher has an email address. Teachers should reply by the end of the next school day.
 - Please feel free to CC me on any emails you would like brought to my attention
- If you would like to speak to a teacher before/after school, or by phone, please try to make an appointment with the teacher ahead of time when possible
- Teachers should NOT be contacted by personal phone or text
 - If you are socially connected with a teacher – it is still best to use their school email or to call the school phone number if you need to reach them concerning your child
- Thank you for your cooperation in respecting our teachers' time and privacy



School /Playground Access

- Door Codes

- Each family is issued a 4 digit code (XXXX#)
- Opens school doors during extended care hours (7-8 a.m. & 3:30-6:00 p.m.)
- Does NOT work during school hours – please buzz to enter school and check in at the office
- Opens playground evenings/ weekends
