



# School Day

- School Day: 8:00 3:20
  - Arrival 7:40-7:55
  - 8:00 Tardy bell rings, doors close
  - Mass 8:05 a.m.
  - Morning Recess begins at 10:30
  - Lunch begins at 11:00
  - Afternoon Recess (PreK-2)
  - Final pick up 3:30
    - Any child not picked up by 3:30 head to extended care

# Extended Care

- All students are automatically enrolled. Children who do not regularly attend the program are welcome to drop-in any day.
- Hours
  - 7:00 a.m. 7:40 a.m. & 3:30 6:00 p.m.
- Rate
  - \$1.00 / 15 min. for up to 2 children
  - \$2.00 flat daily fee for the third child in the same family.
  - Subsequent children will not be charged.
  - Charged by 15 min. increments
- Students who arrive before 7:40 will be asked to go to extended care
- Students will dismiss with class if they are not picked up by 3:30 they will go to extended care

## Illness or Absence

- Please call or email the school as soon as you know your child will be absent – 402-466-3710 – St.PatrickLincolnSchool@cdolinc.net
- Students with a fever in school or who vomit in school will be sent home
  - Please keep students at home until they are fever or vomit free for 24 hours
  - Please keep students at home until they have had one full meal without vomiting
- Missed work can be picked up via the gym doors on school days from 3:30-6:00 p.m. or after mass on the weekends
  - use family code to enter gym doors
- All students coming or leaving from 8:00-3:20 must check in with the school office



# School/Playground Access

### Door Codes

- Each family is issued a 4 digit code (XXXX#)
- Opens gym doors during extended care hours (7-8 a.m. & 3:30-6:00 p.m.)
- Absent work is left daily right inside the gym doors and can be picked up during Ex.
   Care hours
- Does NOT work during school hours please buzz to enter school and check in at the office
- Opens playground evenings/ weekends



# Dress Code

- Tan / navy pants & shorts NO exterior pockets
  - Shorts & no leggings season fall/spring
  - Pants & ankle-length leggings in winter
  - Girls may wear tan/navy skirts with shorts under
  - Girls may wear tan/navy skorts, jumpers, polo dresses
- Green, Navy, or White polo shirts
  - Logos optional
- St. Patrick logo sweatshirt OR any plain sweatshirt in uniform colors
- Hooded sweatshirts as coats only
- Socks with small logos in black, white, or gray
- Hair for boys not to cover ears, eyes, or collar
- Spirit Day t-shirts with jeans or uniform bottoms for spirit day

### Polo Shirt

Can be work in white, green, or navy. Polo shirts can be long or short sleeve. All undershirts should be white, black, navy or gray. Non-Banded polos need to be tucked in at all times. Items with a logo can be purchased through ArtFX before school and during 2 promotional periods throughout the school year.













### Pants and Short

Can be work in white, green, or navy. No denim / exterior pockets. Beginning at 3rd grade, pants and shorts must be worn with a brown or black belt and have belt loops.













### Skirts, skorts, and jumpers

Can be work in white, green, or navy. **Any** style skirt or jumper in the colors listed that falls no shorter than 2 in. from the knee is OK. Plaid skirts in 'Pius Plaid' from Dennis Uniform are allowed beginning in 6th grade.











### Outerwear / Spirit Wear

Sweatshirts in gray, green, and navy (crew and 1/4 zip), Fleece and Athletic Jackets in black (full and 1/4 zip) are allowed to be worn over a uniform polo during the school day. St. Patrick Tshirts can be worn on Spirit Days. Items with a logo can be purchased through ArtFX before school and during 2 promotional periods throughout the school year. St. Patrick Logo's are optional—any of these items can be purchased and worn without the logo.











### Hair, Jewelry, Sock, Nails

Hair must be neatly kept and natural in color. Jewelry and hair accessories should be modest. Socks should be solid black, white, or gray. NO make up, nail polish, or fake tattoos. After a written notice, any makeup, nail polish, hair coloring, or fake tattoos should be removed before returning to school the next day.

### Shorts and skirt lengths


Shorts and skirts should be NO SHORTER than 2 inches above the knee.

To measure at home—you can have the child kneel and then measure from the floor up.

Students will receive 1 warning each semester before parents are called to bring a change of clothes.







# Dress Code - Pre School

- All tops must have sleeves (no tank tops)
- Girls must wear shorts or leggings under dresses and skirts
- Pants ONLY (no shorts) Oct. 15th March 15th
- Athletic shoes required (NO sandals or boots)
- No Jewelry except for stud earrings worn by girls



# Lunch

- Student lunches are \$3.55. Adult and Visitor Lunches are \$4.25.
  - \*May change this is the most updated info I have
- Families may check balance and pay via cash or check or through MySchoolBucks
- Free and Reduced Lunch Forms Available at Meet the Teacher
  - Many families qualify for free & reduced lunch if you think you might qualify...apply!
  - Money from Federal Grants based on # of families who qualify
- No child will be denied a lunch please make payments in a timely manner

# Teacher Communication

- Teachers are contracted to be at the school from 7:30-3:30
- Teachers will email weekly about what to expect the upcoming week (topics taught in class, reminders, projects, etc.)
- Each teacher has an email address. Teachers should reply by the end of the next school day.
  - Please feel free to CC me on any emails you would like brought to my attention
- If you would like to speak to a teacher before/after school, or by phone, please try to make an appointment with the teacher ahead of time when possible
- Teachers should NOT be contacted by personal phone or text
  - If you are socially connected with a teacher it is still best to use their school email or to call the school phone number if you need to reach them concerning your child

# Ways to Help Your Child be Successful!

- Read the school newsletter, add important events/reminders to you calendar.
- Check and empty your child's backpack each night. Important notes will come home.
   Keep in contact with the teachers and they will do the same. This is a partnership and communication is the key.
- Ask your child to tell about the best part of their day (and tell the best part of your day too!)
- Have a consistent routine at home and make sure your child is well-rested for school each morning.
- Minimize absences where possible
  - Pick-up and complete absent work in a timely manner
